30	Introduction	Participants are able to differentiate between different acts of discrimination.	 In groups of 3 or 4 participants are given half an hour to research different acts of discrimination and their solutions. They shall choose 3 that they think they can act out in a role play (Teaching material: Fotosituations) Small groups
45	Learning activity 1	Participants are able to (critically) portray acts of discrimination in role plays.	 After selecting the situations that participants are going to act, they will be given around 45 minutes to rehearse their three short role-plays. They will then act them out to the rest of the group. Individual / group setting
40	Learning activity 2	Participants are able to take relevant notes during a role play.	 Whilst watching other groups act out their situations, notes should be taken with regards to the different act of discrimination and possible solutions to those acts. Group setting
30	Learning activity 3	Participants are able to take part in a discussion and explain their point of view.	A group discussion will be facilitated, with the main topic of discussion being the solutions that were portrayed. What was



		good about them and what was bad? How to act in a tense situation? • Group setting
