TOPIC: Why people flee from there home country

TIME (in minutes)	TYPE OF TRAINING ACTIVITY	ACTIVITY OUTCOMES	FORMAT (References to further detail)
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5	Introduction part I	Trainers introduce themselves to group; introduction of topic and overview of workshop programme	Introductory sequence / warm-up activity
10	Introduction part II	Familiarise participants with topic through audiovisual content.	Introducing the participants to a video and providing them with information on flight, emphasising that it is not a phenomenon of the 21st century, as shown by the largest refugee movements in Austria since the Second World War.
20-30	Learning activity part I	Participants' awareness of why people flee from their home countries is raised. They understand the reasons and motives for fleeing.	Individual work / or work in groups: name at least 3 reasons, which could make people flee from their home country.
20-30	Learning activity part II		Presentation of findings, focusing on the topic "What could be reasons for me to flee from my home country?" Cards are clustered according to content - e.g. economic, political, religious, family motives





20-30	Learning activity part III	Participants can give their opinion and contribute to group discussions.	Group discussion about from "what would you as a refugee wish/expect from your host country and how would it feel being a refugee?"
5-10	Closing sequence		Q & A session
