| 20 | Learning activity I | Participants gain basic knowledge on development of EU. | <u>Social form:</u> Pairs of two / group setting <u>Task:</u> Quiz on EU; discussion of results in class; |

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| 10 | Mini-presentation II | Participants gain basic knowledge on workings of EU. | <u>Social form:</u> Group setting / interactive |
| 15 | Learning activity II | Participants form own opinion on importance of EU. | <u>Task I:</u> Mini-presentation on EU part II; additionally short video clip on EU <u>Task II:</u> Participants write short text about EU and why they believe EU is important; volunteers can share their ideas in class |
