Cozy mood online talk - workshop

PART 1 – 30 min.	5 – 5,30 PM
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- * Arrival of participants, technical preparation and support for participants
- * Time for fetching some tea and to prepare the cozy mood – each participant individually
- * Opening of the workshop and introduction by Karolína Mašková and Leonhard Skorka
- * Greeting the participants and letting them to introduce themselves
- * Introduction of the Volunteer Centre and the WakeUP project

PART 2 – 1 hour	5,30 – 6,30 PM
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- * Leonhard introducing the international volunteer service for the youth
- * Political influence of the individual – Political griping
 - How can we change something and disagree as a citizen?
- * Using mentimeter to gather ideas of participants and leading the discussion about those ideas
 - Explaining how the cultural stereotype effects people – ‚czechs complain a lot‘ can actually help if we use it effectively
 - Ways of influencing public decisions
 - Showing examples of using those ways in the past (citizens from Dryden, USA)
 - What concerns you as a citizen?
- * Mentimeter – gathering opinions and then sharing ideas of participants in a group, leading the discussion and finding the effective solutions for their problems
- * MENTIMETER gathering of ideas
- * PRESENTATION of ideas of the whole group
- * DISCUSSION over the question and ideas in the group

PART 3 – 1 hour 6,30 -7,30 PM

*GENDER EQUALITY – It probably doesn't even matter

- Explaining what feminism and gender equality are?
- Explaining gender roles in the society

*Doing an online live Quiz in the presentation shared through Google Meet– participants guess which pictures mean certain gender roles

*Leading the discussion with the whole group – Do they know other examples of gender roles? Did they experienced them?

- Showing examples of the gender equality in the world, pointing to cultural differences leading to different stages of human rights
- The development of women's rights in the Czech Republic – voting

* ,Opening a discussion about number 22, sharing opinions in a group about equal salaries for both sexes

- Acquainting the group with the term GPG - Gender pay gap and Project 22% to equality in the CZ
- How do gender stereotypes and sexism effect people? Examples of people who achieved something in this field.

*Activity – participants wrote down one life experience, shared it with the group (if they wanted to) and the others tried to imagine the situation and tried to find the solution – what to do in the situation, how to handle it.

- 4 steps to follow to fight for gender equality

*DISCUSSION over the ideas, opinions

*DOING THE QUIZ in the presentation about gender roles

*ACTIVITY – gathering everyone's experience, mirroring the situation to different participant, trying to find the solution together

*EVALUATION of the workshop – thanking participants for attending, answering questions and saying goodbye.
