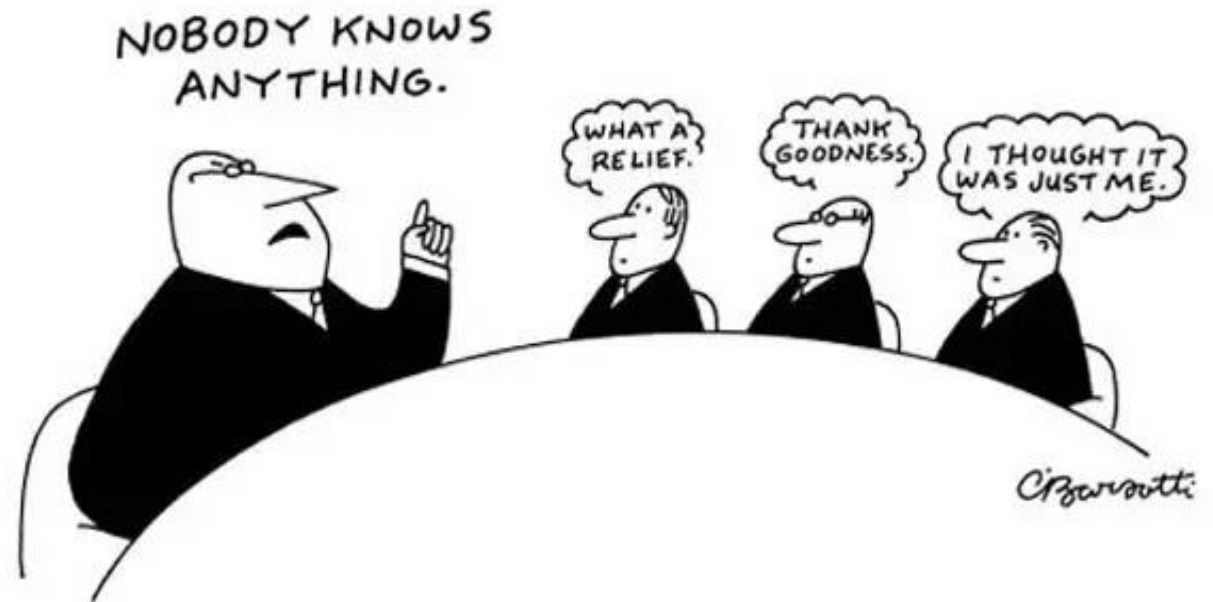


1. INITIAL ATTITUDE - SELF-REFLECTION

- What is your initial position on this topic?
- What do you already know (guess) about it?
- What influenced your attitude?
- In what ways did you get informed?
- Choose the general position you stand for as a group



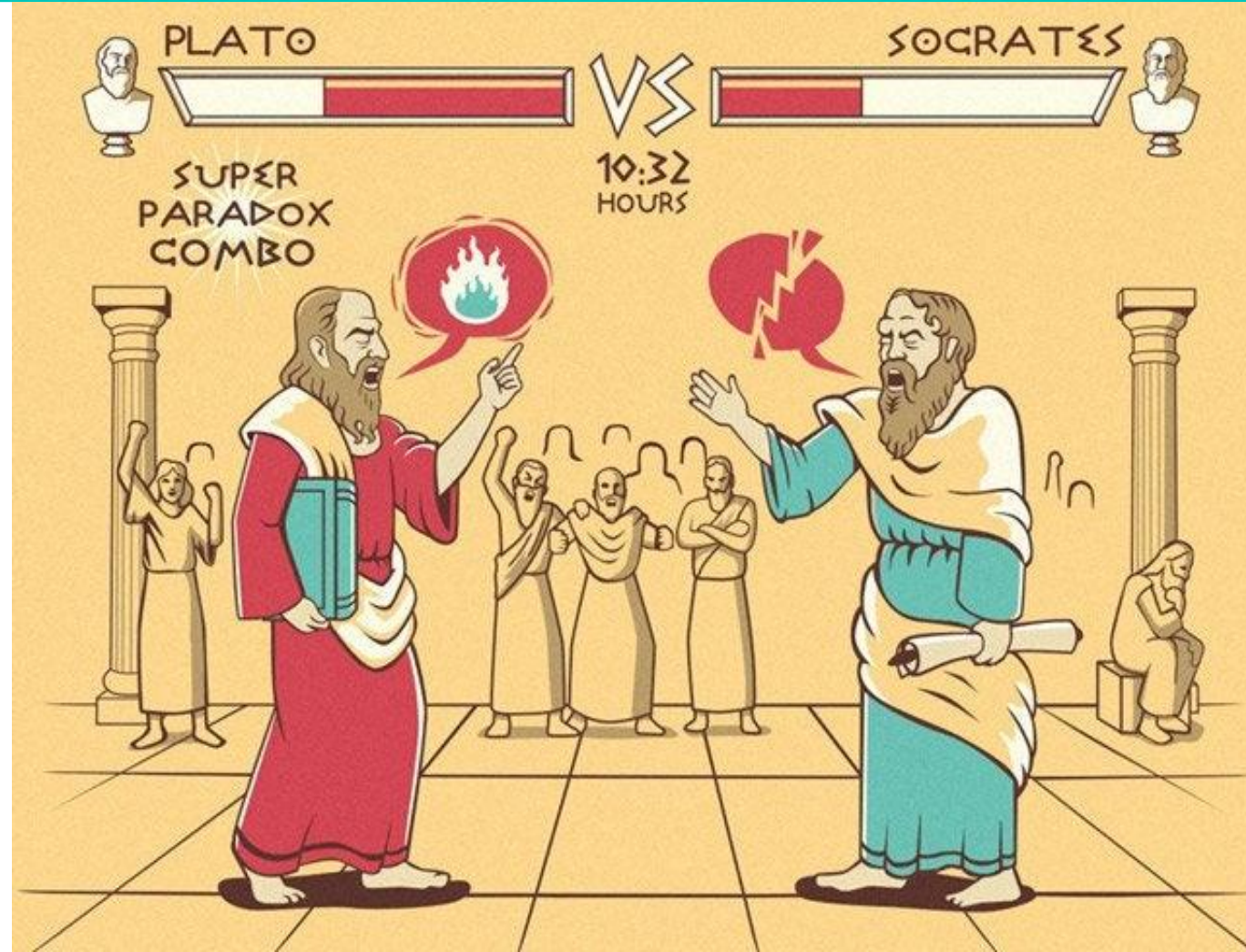
2. INITIAL ATTITUDE ANALYSIS (RELEVANCE, ACCURACY)

- Analyze how accurate are the previous information; Investigate the accuracy and relevance of the information mentioned
- Discuss how much the accuracy of the data matches your new assumptions



3. DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES - ANTITHESIS

- Investigate and analyze thesis that differ from yours
- Try to understand and experience them
- Find argumentation for such attitudes
- Investigate the accuracy of these theses



4. TAKING A POSITION

- Think of all the pros and cons of the arguments of thesis and antithesis
- After the analysis, take a position that is supported by more relevant arguments
- Try to be objective! Don't think about your starting point!
